The Governments of Malaysia and Brunei Darussalam recognize that access to traditional knowledge associated to the biodiversity including genetic resources, as well as the equitable sharing of benefits that may result from the utilisation of that traditional knowledge, can be adequately addressed through contracts or other instruments that reflect mutually agreed terms between users and resource providers.
